Communication may be carried out both in German and English. RESCUE STUTTGART (RFFS) will report "ready for contact" to Stuttgart TWR. Frequency change to the rescue frequency may only be performed on request of the cockpit crew or after instruction by Stuttgart TWR. Initial call on rescue frequency is always executed by cockpit crew.
