Area minimum altitude (AMA)	
Each 1° quadrilateral contains an area minimum altitude (AMA) which represents the lowest altitude which may be used under instrument meteorological conditions (IMC). The AMA provides a minimum clearance of 1000 ft (2000 ft in mountainous areas) above all obstacles in the quadrilateral. It is represented in thousands and tens of feet above mean sea level.	
Example: 10200 feet	<b>10<sub>2</sub></b>
